

Are your exterior door jambs starting to show signs of deterioration from water damage?

Do you know that if not dealt with, this could cost you thousands of dollars in rot repairs to your house structure?

What is RE-JAMB (Protective Door Jamb Covers & Shield Guards)? RE-JAMB is a maintenance free white PVC product new to the market made to cover, seal, and protect the existing wood door jambs. They can be painted if desired. RE-JAMB comes in 2 different kit sizes and will fit most exterior wood jambs for 2 x 4 or 2 x 6 home construction.

Kit # 1: (Protective Door Jamb Covers) Will fit most single door unit 3'-0" x 6'-8" or smaller. Kit # 2: (Shield Guards) Will fit most doors, including patio and entry door units.

Kits # 1: (Protective Door Jamb Covers) Are made to cover the entire top and sides of the wood door jambs to

and feature a pre-determined groove for easy cutting.

protect them from the elements. It is recommended that Kit #1 be installed by a professional contractor.

Kit #2: (Shield Guards) are made to cover just 1 foot of the bottom side of the wood door jambs where most damage occurs. Shield Guards are recommended for Homeowner installation and are easy to install. Only tools required: Utility knife and Caulking gun.

RE-JAMB (Protective Door Jamb Covers and Shield Guards) come in pre-determined widths to fit standard door jamb sizes

In the past, when a door jamb started to show sign of deterioration, the only way to repair it was to replace the entire door unit (door and frame). This can be very expensive because it entails removing and replacing interior and exterior wood trim casings, removing and replacing the door unit, and in some cases removing and replacing some of the house siding as well. The cost for a single door unit replacement will typically cost between \$800.00 to \$1000.00, plus miscellaneous trim materials, not including any rot damage that may be found after door unit is removed. RE-JAMB kit # 1 (Protective Door Jamb Covers) will typically cost 1/3 of the cost of a door replacement. RE-JAMB kit # 2 (Shield Guard), will typically cost 1/10 of the cost of a door replacement. Composite exterior trim casings and weather strips are not included.

WARNING:

This product is not recommended for use if the existing door frame is rotted. This product should only be used before any wood rot issues have occurred. Application of RE-JAMB over a rotted door jamb may cause serious damage to the house structure that is behind the jamb. If rot has already occurred and RE-JAMB is placed over the rotted door jamb, this may worsen the issue. To check for rot, take a screwdriver and push on the wood, if the screwdriver goes through the wood, this is an indication that the wood is rotted.
